In this installation exhibition supported by artists' collective Eyesaw entitled *e ni kaita mochi wa kuenu* ("you can't eat the mochi in a picture"), Iranian-American artist fereshteh toosi presents figurative illustrations of Japanese and English proverbs using found objects and household items. Entering friends' homes as a visual scientist and gathering specimens, toosi offers an invitation to pyromaniacs: "I challenge everyone to ignite small fires by holding a magnifying glass over the objects, speech, and routines of our daily lives. From the clothesline to the kitchen table, art is happening in every home in the city."
